Ms. LI Fang currently serves as Head of the Police Component of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA). She is a senior police officer with thirty years of law enforcement experience in Shanghai, China. Holding the rank of Police Commissioner, Third Class, she has extensive management experience across various departments of the Shanghai Police Force. Her areas of expertise include public order management, command and control, immigration, traffic management, economic crime investigation, and community policing, as well as training, human resources, strategic planning, and related fields.
