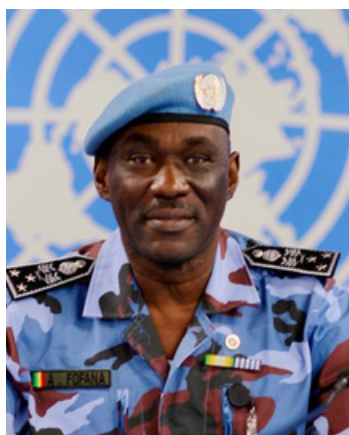




AMADOU FOFANA

Deputy Police Commissioner

Dr Amadou Fofana, a Police Controller General from Mali, was appointed Deputy Police Commissioner of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic (MINUSCA) in August 2024. Since 1 October 2025, he has been serving as Acting Head of the MINUSCA Police Component. He has more than 20 years of experience in peacekeeping and international security cooperation.

Prior to this appointment, Dr Fofana served as Director of Health and Social Affairs Services of the Malian National Police, where he implemented sustainable welfare programmes, laid the groundwork for the establishment of a Level 2 police hospital, and strengthened an integrated centre for the care and support of survivors of gender-based violence (“One Stop Centre”).

From 2011 to 2019, Dr Fofana served as Director of Police Courses at the Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre (KA IPTC) in Accra, where he oversaw training programme development and the strategic planning of UNPOL pre-deployment training for police services in West and Southern Africa.

From 2019 to 2023, Dr Fofana served as Senior Police Advisor with the Strategic Capacity Group (SCG), supporting the Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) in Bangui. In this capacity, he designed and led training programmes for local security forces on gender, community policing and leadership.

Dr Fofana is also a part-time lecturer at the Centre for Analysis and Research on the Sahel-Saharan Region (CARESS) of the Alioune Blondin Beye Peacekeeping School (EMPABB). He serves as a consultant for the African Union and the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), contributing to the assessment and harmonization of training for contingents pre-positioned for the African Standby Force.

He has also served as a consultant for the United Nations Integrated Training Service (ITS), contributing to programmes aimed at structuring and strengthening training frameworks. He is a permanent instructor at EMPABB.
