Chief of the Justice and Corrections

Frank Dalton is the current Chief of the Justice and Corrections Section, a role he began in August 2014. In this role, he oversees the implementation of all the Mission's rule of law programming, including the fight against impunity, support for the extension of State authority through the justice and penitentiary systems, reform of the prison system and the establishment and operationalization of the Special Criminal Court. Prior to joining MINUSCA, he was the Chief of the Justice Section in MINUSTAH (2011-2014), the Head of Rule of Law & Human Rights Department with the OSCE in Albania (2003-2011), the Country Director for Southeast Europe with the Civic Education Project (1994-2003). Between 1994 and 2003, he was also a visiting lecturer at Aleksander Xhuvani University, the University of Tirana and the Albanian School of Magistrates. He has a Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Government from Harvard University and a Juris Doctor (JD) from Columbia University
