### UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES<sup>1</sup>

- As of 18 June, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 136,590 including 74,090 in Bentiu, 28,663 in Juba UN House, 30,410 in Malakal, 2,374 in Bor, 2,135 in Melut and 365 in Wau.

- Bentiu PoC: Numbers of internally displaced persons (IDPs) expected to reach 78,000 by the end of the week, due to an estimated 1000 arrivals daily**
- Juba: Numbers have decreased due to new head and households count**

### ACTIVITIES IN PROTECTION SITES

#### *Juba*

- Relocation of IDPs from POC 2 to POC3 completed, with 1187 relocations
- 83 youth benefited from an ICRC three month course in life skills peace and conflict resolution, and graduated this week.

## **Bor**

UNMISS Civil Affairs Section completed a two-day training on conflict management for POC block leaders.

## ***Bentiu and Malakal***

Relocation IDPs to better and higher ground, with improved drainage and water sanitation, is continuing in Malakal and Bentiu, with a target of having moved everyone before the rainy season fully settles in.
